School Gate Campaign – Guidelines for Distributors

In September 2019 the following new subjects will be introduced in schools throughout England:

- Relationships Education in primary schools;
- Relationships and Sex Education in secondary schools.

In the interests of equality and diversity children will be taught that:

- They can choose their gender;
- If they have a best friend of the same sex they might be gay.

The School Gate Campaign has produced a leaflet for you to distribute outside schools in your local area. The purpose is to encourage parents to find out what is being taught to their children and decide whether or not they agree with it.

If you wish to distribute leaflets, please observe the following guidelines:

- Give out your leaflets from a public footpath outside the school. Do not enter the premises.
- Give out your leaflets in the afternoon when the parents collect their children from school. Do not give them out in the morning because the children might take them into school and it distracts them from their lessons.


Answering Questions

The leaflet makes some suggestions about what might be taught. Don't pretend to know everything. The new subjects are under development and will become compulsory in all schools including independent schools and academies in September 2020. In the meantime, teachers will be trying out various lesson plans and teaching methods, with assistance from external organisations such as Stonewall, Mermaids, Sexwise and Brooks Education. Some of these are prepared to teach almost anything to children at any age and will have a considerable influence on the curriculum.

Political Campaigning

If you intend to stand for election as a political candidate, you will obviously want to target the schools in your electoral area and get to know the parents. The County Council elections in 2021 will be especially important because of their management of State schools.
